Our highly trained and experienced staff will introduce your child to a learning environment like no other, offering a curriculum that is interdisciplinary and dynamic.

Letter generated curriculum, focusing on a “letter of the week”

Students are introduced to the alphabet and begin learning to identify, sound out and write their letters. Each week is themed, exposing the students to a different country or part of the world, life skills (such as scissor and pencil holding). We also introduce the students to American Sign Language.

Cooking and science

Each week a particular scientific or cooking lesson is featured, surrounding the letter of the week. (for example, while studying the letter p, class will make pumpkin bread from scratch) During these lessons patience, turn taking, teamwork, measuring and counting are practiced and explored.

Song and dance

Incorporating music and dance in the classroom fortifies student speech and memory skills while being entertaining fall all. Our students work on presenting a winter and end of the year theatrical production.

Tennis and swim instruction

Students will get their first taste of organized sports and gain valuable skills such as direction taking and teamwork.

Hygiene and Values

Students will practice basic hygiene techniques like tooth brushing and hand washing. They will also be discussing fundamental values like friendship and kindness.

Free Play and Socialization

Whether it is playing in our secure state of the art playground or in one of our classrooms/ gymnasiums, students will have the opportunity to forge their first friendships with classmates and just learn how to independently “be themselves”

Some of our weekly units include: Ancient Egypt, American Presidents, Famous Countries, Ocean Life, Penguins, African Safari, Science of Eggs, Planets and Solar System, Famous Artists of the World, Dr. Seuss Author Study, etc.

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
